Job summary

Responsible for the cultivation and care of the landscaping and grounds surrounding all the school buildings. Plant flowers, mow, pull weeds, prune trees, bushes, raking, sweeping, picking up litter, and edging. Maintain tools, equipment and storage areas.

Tasks

- Perform grounds keeping and minor exterior building maintenance duties.
- Cut lawns using riding mower and push mower and trim sidewalk edges, flower beds and walls.
- Landscape by planting flowers, grass, shrubs, and bushes.
- Perform minor interior maintenance repairs and small carpentry jobs when required.
- Daily safety checks on lawn equipment, and perform maintenance procedures on equipment utilized in grounds keeping.
- Rake, mulch, pull weeds, and prune the grounds as needed.
- Water plants and grass as needed.
- Fertilize when required.
- Maintain parking lots.

- To be able to run equipment for long periods of time
- Able to lift 40 lbs
- Ability to work alone
- To be able to do repetitive work.
- To work with hand and powered carpentry tools
